1st Annual Corona Cinco de Mayo Horse Shoe Tournament

General Rules:

- Single elimination tournament.
- Horseshoes (shoes) for the tournament shall be provided by the Corona Cinco de Mayo Scholarship Committee. Personal horseshoes may be used only if both parties agree.
- Two (2) contestants per team – one (1) stay at each end of the court.
- Contestants must throw from the right or the left side of the platform.
- The contestant pitching will deliver both shoes (one at a time).
- Contestant may switch side but not during the same inning.
- No throwing from inside the pit.
- The pitcher must remain constant contact with the designated platform during the entire address and release of the horseshoe.

Scoring:

- Ringer – (straight edge touching both points) equals three (3) points.
- Leaner – Equals two (2) points.
- Shoes – (the width of the shoe from the stake) equals one (1) point.
- Ringers that are topped negate each other (no score).
- For each team negate each other (no score).
- Only the closest to the stake shoe count. For example, Team A has two shoes within the width of a shoe to a stake. Team B has one but it is closer than Team A's, then Team B gets one (1) point.
- Competing teams keep score.
- Contestants pick-up shoes and decide scoring. When teams cannot come to an agreement, a tournament judge will make the ruling. **All rulings by a tournament judge are final.**
- In the event of a tie, a two (2) inning tie breaker shall be played. Should a tie still remain after the tie-breaker has been played, the process shall be repeated until the tie has been broken.

Fouls:

The following occurrences are considered foul shoes and must be removed from the pit.

- Any Shoe which contacts the background, court game or any ground outside the pit before it comes to rest.
- A contestant's shoe or shoes shall be called foul (no points) if the contestant removes any shoe before scoring of that shoe has been agreed upon.
